

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# //अधिसूचना//

माननीय उच्च न्यायालय बिलासपुर द्वारा WPC 211/2024, 279/2024, 298/2024, 683/2024, 1174/2024, 1246/2024 में निर्देशित NMC के नियमों के परिपालन में निम्नानुसार अधिसूचना जारी की जाती है —

#### A. Attendance-

- 1. There shall be minimum 75% attendance in theory and 80 % in practical for eligibility to appear for examination in that subject.
- 2. In subjects that are taught in more than one phase- the learner must have 75% attendance in theory and 80% in practical in each phase of instruction in that subject.
- 3. There shall be minimum 80% attendance in family visits under family adaptation programme.
- 4. If an examination comprises more than one subject (For example for general surgery and allied branches) the candidate must have a minimum 75% attendance in each subject including its allied branches and 80% attendance in each clinical posting.
- 5. Learner who do not have at least 75% attendance in the electives will not be eligible for the final part II/ NEXT.
- 6. If the attendance is inadequate at the time of annual examination, the student can not appear in supplementary examination, such student is required to take classes with junior batch to compensate for his attendance deficit, specially the course he/she missed. Student will be eligible to appear in the examination with junior batch.
- 7. Remedial measures for attendance However, before the commencement of annual examination the college authority can arrange upto 20% additional classes (subject wise-lectures/ practical/clinical hours as allotted by NMC eg. In Anatomy out of 210 hours lectures, maximum 42 hours of additional remedial classes) to compensate for attendance deficit as per availability & feasibility of the institute. Not more than 20%.

Student who are not able to compensate after the additional remedial classes, will be not eligible for annual examination as well as supplementary examination, such students is required to take extra classes with junior batch. Student will be eligible to appear in examination with junior batches.

#### B. Internal Examination-

Assessment of internal examination as per subject performa attached (Excel sheet attached).

- 1. To assess the internal marks, there shall be no less than three internal assessment in each Pre/ Para clinical subjects and no less than two examinations in each clinical subjects in professional years.
- 2. When subjects are taught in more than one phase, the internal assessment must be done in each phase and must contribute proportionately to final assessment. For example general medicine must be assessed in second professional, third professional part-I, third professional part-II independently.
- 3. The final internal assessment in a board clinical specialty (e.g. Surgery and allied specialties, Medicine & its specialties etc.) shall comprise of marks from all the constituent specialties. The proportion of the marks for each constituent specialty shall be determined by the time of instruction allotted to each.
- 4. The sessional examination preceding the university examination may be similar to pattern of university examination.
- 5. The result of internal assessment must be displayed on the notice boardwithin one week of the test.
- 6. Total marks (As per NMC Subject wise marks attached) 50% combined theory and practical (Not less than 40% in each) for eligibility for university examinations. At the time of University examination internal marks well be submitted by the department in foil and counterfoil and the number prescribed by NMC subject wise example Anatomy theory 500 and practical 500 (not in the form of previously send 40 marks).
- 7. Remedial measures for Internal Examination -

For students who are either not able to score qualifying marks or have missed on some assessments due to any reason, once a retest must be conducted within 15 days of result declaration of that internal examinations, with prior notification of the date to concerned students.

- 1. After each PCT & Pre-University exams results of Internal Assessment should be displayed on notice board along with their attendance (both in theory & practical/clinical posting in separate heads) within 7 days of that exam.
  - 2. It is also recommended that students should sign with date whenever they are shown Internal Assessment records in token of having seen and discussed the marks
  - 3. The Internal assessment marks and attendance till that date must be uploaded to college website so that it is available to both students and their parents.
  - 4. The Head of the institutions must communicate to parents that all future periodical internal examination results and attendance till that date will be uploaded in the college website (with clearly mentioning website link where it information will be available) for them to view their wards performance and attendance. 08/05/2024
